EMPLOYEE FIRST TRACKS - NOV 22

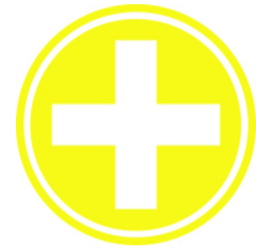
