TIPS & TRICKS TO GET YOU ON THE HILL

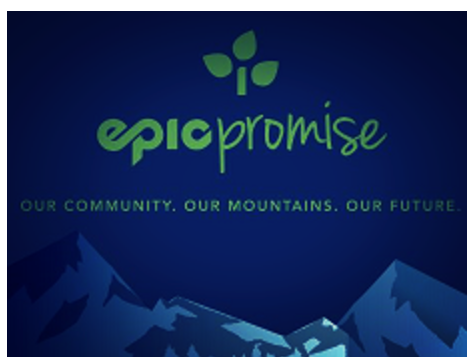
